



How We Are Keeping Guests & Staff Safe

New York State, CDC and the World Health Organization (WHO) have provided best practice information which we have utilized in our response.

Staff

All staff answer a questionnaire and have a temperature check on arrival to work, assuring they have no symptoms of Covid-19. All staff are asked to stay home should they suspect infection. All staff are instructed to wear gloves and masks and frequently disinfect work-stations.

Guests

All guests will be screened for fever and are asked to refrain from entering if they have any symptoms of Covid-19. Although WHO currently recommends 3 feet as safe distancing, we will follow NY guidelines of a minimum 6 feet between tables. We ask that guests consider others and make every attempt to give others a 6 foot space while moving about. We ask guests to follow Entrance/Exit and directionality signage.

Facility

All surfaces with an expectation of customer contact (Doors, Chairs, Tables, etc.) will be cleaned continuously throughout the day. Restrooms will be disinfected before each use. Surfaces with a lesser chance of skin contact (floors, walls, etc.) will be cleaned on a daily basis. Due to the high molecular weight of Covid-19 (22 Million Daltons), there is very little risk of contamination of ceilings or distant surfaces. These surfaces will be cleaned on a biweekly basis. All dishware and utensils will be run through a sanitizer, but if customers prefer, disposable utensils and dishes are available. Likewise, linen will be washed with a bleach additive to assure disinfection.

We will be updating our policies as public health sources provide additional recommendations.
