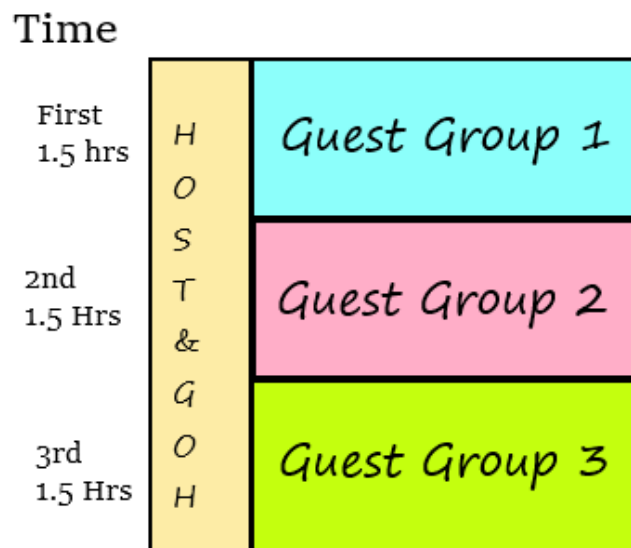


INFORMATION FOR BOOKED PARTIES

Chat Noir firmly believes we will be able to once again enjoy in-person celebrations with friends and family in the near future. We also believe health concerns will result in a **transition period** from the current Pandemic lockdown to normalcy. We don't as of yet know when this transition period will start or end, or even the rules, but we believe the proposals below may help party hosts and Guests of Honor (GOH) decide whether to cancel events or continue to plan an event.

1. Extended Party Hours

We believe large gatherings (size to be determined) may be discouraged by health officials and, additionally, make some guests uncomfortable. We are proposing lengthening parties to 4.5 hours with the intention of minimizing the number of guests present at any one time (see diagram below). Although subject to change, we would start morning parties 1 hour earlier, start afternoon parties a half hour later, and end afternoon parties 2 hours later (4Pm to 8:30PM). All guests will be evaluated for symptoms prior to entering.



For example, a party with 30 guests (28+Host+GOH) would have one group of 9 invitees arrive for the first 1.5 hours and depart before the next group arrives, etc. The Host and Guest of Honor will remain for the entire time. We will serve each group individually and keep areas of the room clean for the next group to arrive.

2. Cleaning

Staff will be wiping down tables and chairs before and after each guest departs. Common areas (bathroom/doors) will be disinfected regularly.

3. Staff

Staff will wear masks and disposable gloves at all times. When possible, staff with positive antibody tests will wear visible identification as such.

All of the above anticipate directives from Public Health Agencies and require advance consultation between the Party Booker and Chat Noir.
